Daily Rosary 11:30am Mon-Fri, 11am Sat. Followed by the Angelus.



Three good news regarding your great support to St Mary's Shrine:

- 1. Thank you to the *Jane & Stephen Murphy* Foundation who funded the new alarm system in the Sanctuary and Side Chapels. This completes the CCTV circuit installed earlier. This equipment should allow us to keep St Mary's open longer every day safely.
- 2. Thank you to the parishioners who funded the new red carpet, soon to be fitted on the altar steps. It will enhance visually the Sanctuary and will also muffle the priest's footsteps on the wooden platform.
- 3. £226 weekly increase! The previous assessment of our weekly income was £1,063. We have now reached £1,289 / week! This is £199/week standing orders, plus £1,090/week average in the collection plate over the last three months. Thank you for your generosity! Our weekly deficit has thus shrunk to *only* £155. Soon, please God, we will have reached the equilibrium, with a weekly income matching the reckoned £1,444/week running costs (all included).

Holy Communion Reminder:

- To receive Holy Communion, one must be 1) a Roman Catholic 2) in state of grace (no grave sin unabsolved on one's conscience) and 3) have fasted for at least one hour.
- In the traditional Latin rite used at St Mary's, Holy Communion is received kneeling (if one can), and in any case on the tongue: thank you very much in advance.
- Please **use the entire width of the Communion rail**, from one wall of the church all the way to the opposite wall, avoiding any gaps. This will make distribution quicker. Thank you.
