Holy Communion Reminder:

- To receive Holy Communion, one must be 1) a Roman Catholic 2) in state of grace (no grave sin unabsolved on one's conscience) and 3) have fasted for at least one hour.
- In the traditional Latin rite used at St Mary's, Holy Communion is received kneeling (if one can), and in any case on the tongue: thank you very much in advance.
- Please use the entire width of the Communion rail, from one wall of the church all the way to the opposite wall, avoiding any gaps. This will make distribution quicker. Thank you.

Did you know? St Mary's Shrine costs £1,444 a week to run and maintain, but our current income is £1,063 per week. Please give generously!

Jacinta loved to pray daily for the Holy Father. Let us ask their intercession and aspire to imitate them and Sr Lucia. May Russia convert and spread the Gospel to the world!
