Saturday 17 June:

- 11am Priestly ordination of Deacons Alex Stewart, FSSP and Krzysztof Sanetra, FSSP by Archbishop Malcolm McMahon of Liverpool
- 1:30pm Refreshments in Priory Garden – while First Blessings are given by the new priests
- 2pm Buffet Lunch at nearby venue
- 5pm Vespers

Sunday 18 June:

- 11am First Solemn High Mass of then-Father Alex Stewart, FSSP on the Feast of Corpus Christi, with First Holy Communion of children
- 12:30pm First Blessing by Fr Stewart and Picnic lunch in Priory Garden
- 3pm: Corpus Christi Procession led by Fr Alex Stewart, FSSP with wider parish

Volunteers are needed for (among many other things):

Please be advised LiveMass cameras record in this church. To share the riches of the traditional liturgy globally, each day Holy Mass will soon be broadcast live on the Internet and stored for future viewing.

SHRINE weekly RUNNING COSTS soon covered?

We had a £226 weekly increase! The previous assessment of our weekly income was **£1,063**. **We have now reached £1,289 / week!** This is £199/week standing orders, plus £1,090/week average in the collection plate over the last three months. Thank you for your generosity! Our weekly deficit has thus shrunk to **only £155**. Soon, please God, we will have reached the equilibrium, with a weekly income matching the reckoned £1,444/week running costs (all included).

Three ways you can help us reach £1,444/week **without your spending more:**

1. Take several St Mary's Shrine **coloured flyers** from the back of the church and spread them around you. This is the most effective way to encourage people to come to St Mary's, even only occasionally.
2. Ask us for a Gift Aid Form (if you pay taxes), allowing us to claim an added 25% from the government at no extra cost to you.
3. Give to St Mary's directly through your bank, rather than in cash through the weekly collection basket. This means less time spent counting cash by our staff and no fees taken by bank when we deposit the cash. Thank you!

Holy Communion Reminder:

- **Communion plate held close enough:**
In the absence of an altar server (any men interested to learn, please contact us), would communicants hold the communion plate in their own hands while kneeling at the Communion Rail? Once you receive the plate from the person on your right, please make sure to bring it close under your chin so as to avoid any gap between your mouth and the plate (thus preventing the Sacred Host from falling unto the floor accidentally). **Ideally, the edge of the plate should touch your throat.** Then, hand the plate to the person on your left. Thank you.
- To receive Holy Communion, one must be 1) a Roman Catholic 2) in state of grace (no grave sin unabsolved on one's conscience) and 3) have fasted for at least one hour.
- In the traditional Latin rite used at St Mary's, Holy Communion is received kneeling (if one can), and in any case on the tongue: thank you very much in advance.
- Please **use the entire width of the Communion rail**, from one wall of the church all the way to the opposite wall, avoiding any gaps. This will make distribution quicker. Thank you.
