All are welcome to attend the Solemn High Mass at 2:30pm, Sunday 2 July at Holywell. The pilgrimage is organised by the Latin Mass Society in honour of St Winefride, Virgin Martyr. Fr Mawdsley will be celebrant, with music directed by Michael Wynne and sung by members of St Mary's choir. Mass at the parish church of St Winefride will be followed by a Rosary Procession to the holy well & veneration of St Winefride's relics. **A number of people are looking for lifts from St Mary's after the Sunday 11am Sung Mass. If you will be driving to Holywell and have space in your car, please ask in the cloister area whether anyone is still waiting for a lift.** Thank you in advance for your kindness.

**Our Blessed Lady of Fatima** is touring families around Warrington. Our Lady wishes to visit every household, wherever invited. Placing her statue in a place of honour, may she receive the prayers and petitions of her children during one week, presenting them to her Divine Son Our Lord Jesus Christ. Every Sunday, the statue will come back to her Shrine (St Mary's Church) in Warrington, thence to accompany another family to their home at the end of Sunday Mass, and stay among them for a week. Holy Communion Reminder:

- To receive Holy Communion, one must be 1) a Roman Catholic 2) in state of grace (no grave sin unabsolved on one's conscience) and 3) have fasted for at least one hour.
- In the traditional Latin rite used at St Mary's, Holy Communion is received kneeling (if one can), and in any case on the tongue: thank you very much in advance.
- Please use the entire width of the Communion rail, from one wall of the church all the way to the opposite wall, avoiding any gaps. This will make distribution quicker. Thank you.

**- Most Pure Heart of Mary, 4 July:**

We invite you to attend the special Mass celebrating the Most Pure Heart of Mary this Tuesday. It is under this title that St Mary's Priory – where your clergy live – was canonically established. The feast normally occurs on the Saturday within the Octave of the Sacred Heart, but the Nativity of St John the Baptist took precedence. The priests at St Mary's and any visitors to the Priory are privileged to have been granted this patronage by the Mother of God. Pray that the hearts of all at St Mary's be configured to her Most Pure Heart.
