Lenten Programme: Besides renewing our resolutions regarding prayer / fasting / almsgiving this Lent, asking God daily for the grace to keep them, to help prepare our souls for Easter there will be:

- Stations of the Cross each Friday at 1pm, led by a priest
- Fr Tim Finigan's leaflets on how to make a good Confession (available in the narthex)
- A series of Monday evening Lenten talks (see overleaf)
- Tenebrae chanted 10-11:30am on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday
- An exhibition on the Holy Shroud of Turin in the narthex for all of Holy Week

Fr de Malleray is away this week leading a clergy retreat at Prior Park near Bath. Priests are bound by canon law to make a spiritual retreat every year, and it is earnestly recommended for laity. Please pray for the fruitfulness of the retreat for all those taking part.

Holy Communion Reminder:

- To receive Holy Communion, one must be 1) a Roman Catholic 2) in state of grace (no grave sin unabsolved on one's conscience) and 3) have fasted for at least one hour.
- In the traditional Latin rite used at St Mary's, Holy Communion is received kneeling (if one can), and in any case on the tongue: thank you very much in advance.
- Please **use the entire width of the Communion rail**, from one wall of the church all the way to the opposite wall, avoiding any gaps. This will make distribution quicker. Thank you.

☞ Did you know? St Mary's Shrine costs £1,444 a week to run and maintain, but our current income is £1,063 per week. Please give generously!



- **CCTV:** Please be advised that the church and priory premises, internal and external, are now covered by CCTV. With this boost to security, we will proceed *ad experimentum* to keep the main porch door of the church open from 10am to 4pm (Monday to Saturday). Ideally there would always be a presence of people praying in the church, and if all goes well we may increase these opening hours in the future.

Be assured that we are committed to data protection. CCTV footage is deleted forever well within a month of being taken (unless there is reason to keep certain images). Meanwhile, we recently suffered what looked like an attempted theft within the church, so please remain vigilant.
