Eucharistic adoration will follow. It is a great honour for our Shrine that the Archbishop is coming to confer this Sacrament. We encourage people to come to the Confirmations, to witness a wonderful growth in life in the Church and in the souls of those who will be Confirmed. Refreshments at 4pm.

- **Our Blessed Lady of Fatima** has arrived in Warrington to begin her Motherly Tour. Our Lady wishes to visit every household, wherever invited. In a place of honour, may she receive the prayers and petitions of her children during one week, presenting them to her Divine Son Our Lord Jesus Christ. Every Sunday, the statue will come back to her Shrine (St Mary's Church) in Warrington, thence to accompany another family to their home at the end of Sunday Mass, and stay among them for a week. Holy Communion Reminder:

- To receive Holy Communion, one must be 1) a Roman Catholic 2) in state of grace (no grave sin unabsolved on one's conscience) and 3) have fasted for at least one hour.
- In the traditional Latin rite used at St Mary's, Holy Communion is received kneeling (if one can), and in any case on the tongue: thank you very much in advance.
- Please use the entire width of the Communion rail, from one wall of the church all the way to the opposite wall, avoiding any gaps. This will make distribution quicker. Thank you.

 **Did you know? St Mary's Shrine costs £1,444 a week to run and maintain, but our current income is £1,063 per week. Please give generously!**

- **Music Room / Narthex / Sacristy:** Our Archbishop is coming twice within one month: to confirm and to ordain. The ordination weekend in particular will involve many clergy. The liturgical preparations certainly require a less confined space than the small working sacristy used over the past 18 months. Even after the ordinations, the sacristy must still provide privacy and recollection for the sacred ministers outside Holy Mass. Despite the discretion of our dedicated singers, the fact that the Choir Room is accessed through the current sacristy (not only for Sunday Mass but for practices and archiving) calls for an improvement. In due course this will be the purchase or building of a proper Shrine Hall—various options have been examined since the first week of our arrival, always with the desire to provide adequate space for our choir. With the launching of LiveMass, the musical excellence of St Mary's will be broadcast live, hopefully attracting more people, and some funding for the Hall. It is in this perspective that I have asked our Director of Music, Michael Wynne, to use the Narthex and adjacent Font Room as Music Room from this week onwards. The total space will be slightly larger than currently used. We will do our utmost to improve this space for our singers to rehearse in good conditions. This will also allow us to move our liturgical furniture and items out of the Priory Front Room, which will then be used for talks and catechism. I thank Michael Wynne and the singers for their generous collaboration and in the name of all, I renew our appreciation and gratitude for the beauty they provide for the worship of God. This arrangement is temporary and we welcome your suggestions for the Shrine Hall project.
