Chair of Unity Octave: Prayers for Christian Unity, 18 - 25 January

The Feast of the Chair of St Peter in Rome is traditionally held on the 18th January, a fitting day to renew our prayers for Christian unity. In 1908 the practice of praying the Chair of Unity Octave was initiated, being a period of eight days during which we pray that all who are separated from the Holy See may return to the Church and also for the success of missions throughout the world. Accordingly, at St Mary's Shrine after the principal Mass each day from 18th - 25th Jan, the following prayer will be recited:

That all may be one as Thou, Father, in Me and I in Thee, that they may be one in Us; that the world may believe that Thou hast sent Me.

V. I say to thee, that thou art Peter.

R. And upon this rock I will build My Church.

Let us pray: *O Lord Jesus Christ, Who didst say to Thine Apostles: Peace I leave you, My peace I give unto you; regard not my sins, but the Faith of Thy Church, and do Thou grant it peace and unity, Who livest and reignest, God, forever, unto ages of ages. Amen.*

Holy Communion Reminder:

- To receive Holy Communion, one must be 1) a Roman Catholic 2) in state of grace (no grave sin unabsolved on one's conscience) and 3) have fasted for at least one hour.
- In the traditional Latin rite used at St Mary's, Holy Communion is received kneeling (if one can), and in any case on the tongue: thank you very much in advance.
- Please **use the entire width of the Communion rail**, from one wall of the church all the way to the opposite wall, avoiding any gaps. This will make distribution quicker. Thank you.

Six FSSP Priests in Warrington this Week

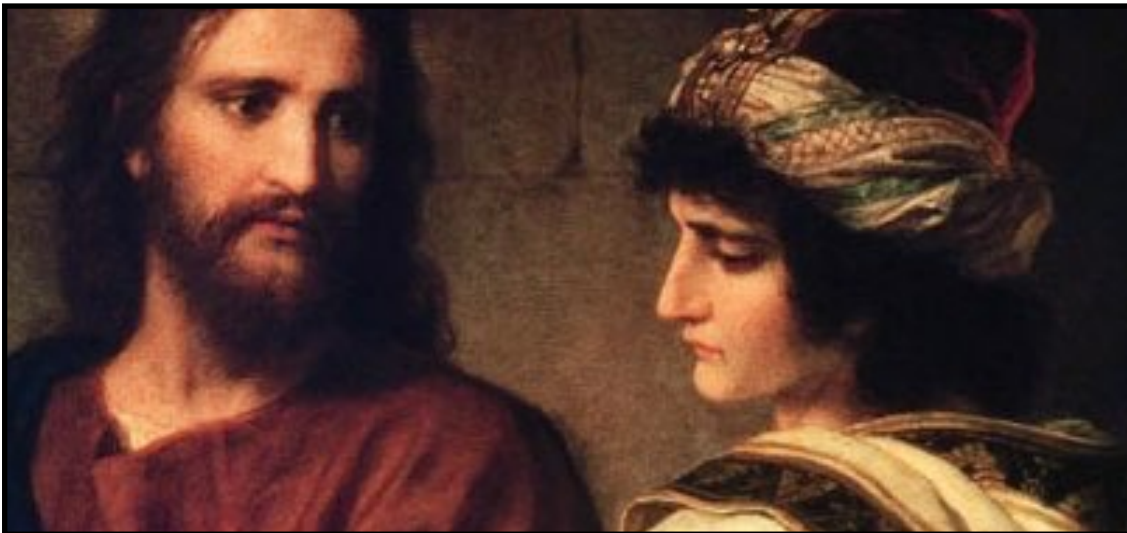
